**Description:**

Lisboa, the capital of Portugal since 1255, was conquered from the Moors by Portugal’s first king in 1147. It lies on the right bank of the Tagus River. From Edward VII Park you will enjoy lovely views towards the city center while crossing it on the way to Belém district. Jerónimos monastery will be the first visit. Looking into the Portuguese discoveries we start to take a look to this old monastery and its very particular art style: the "Manueline". On the other end of this building is located the Maritime Museum, with one of the best collection of boat miniatures from the XVI century. Approaching the river you will see Belém Tower a jewel of the "Manueline" art, built to defend the entrance of Lisbon. Close by you will see the Discoveries Memorial.
